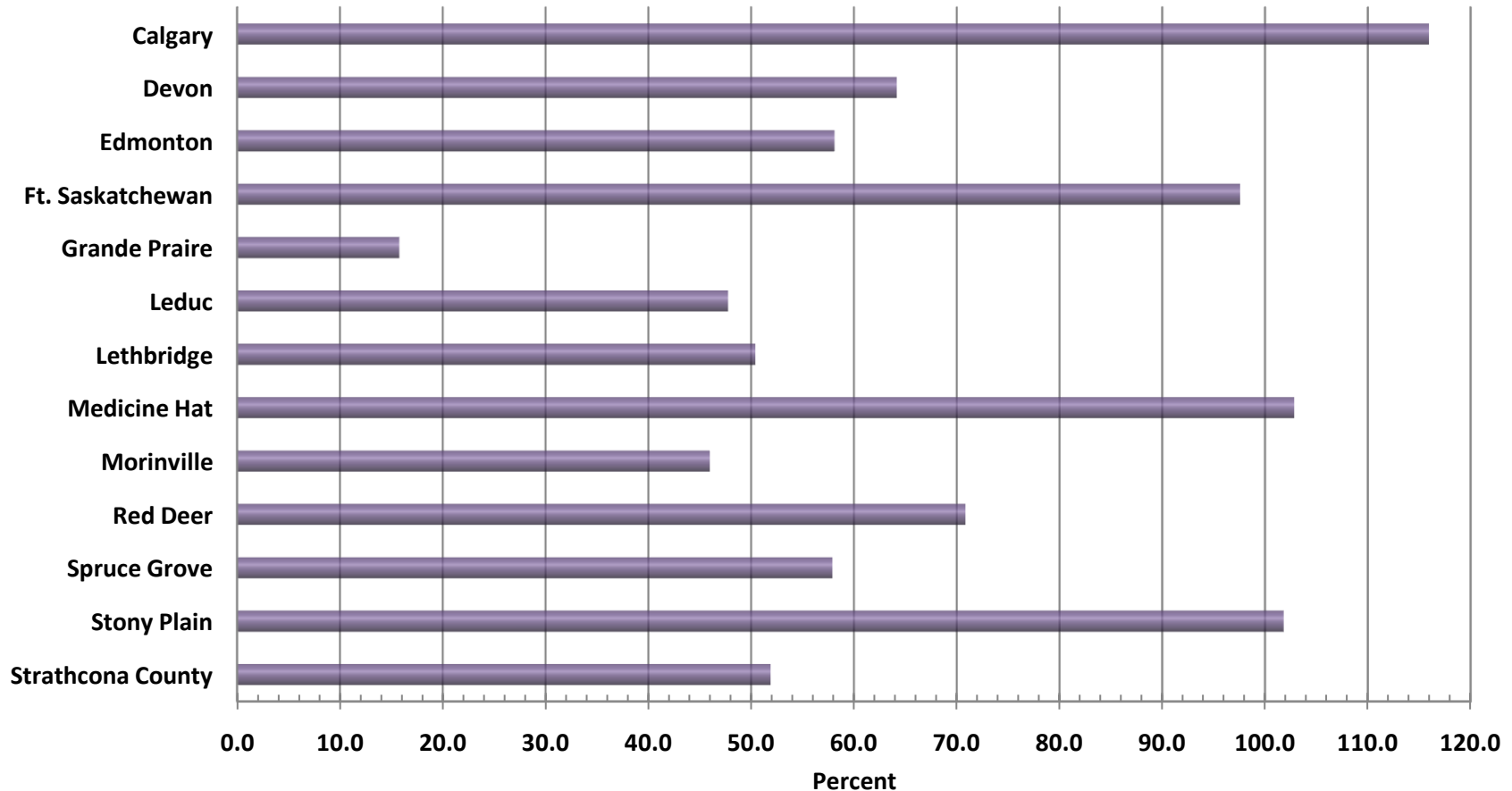


## 2010 Residential Property Tax Differentials

Amount by which St. Albert's Municipal Levy Exceeds that of Other Municipalities



The above chart applies to a **sample house**, defined as 25 to 30 years-old, single-detached, three-bedroom bungalow with a main floor area of 1,200 square feet, a double car garage and finished full basement, on a 6,000 square-foot lot located in an average neighbourhood of the City of Edmonton.

The chart shows how much more a St. Albert property owner of the sample house pays in municipal levies (excluding school taxes) than owners of a similar home located in other municipalities in the Province.
