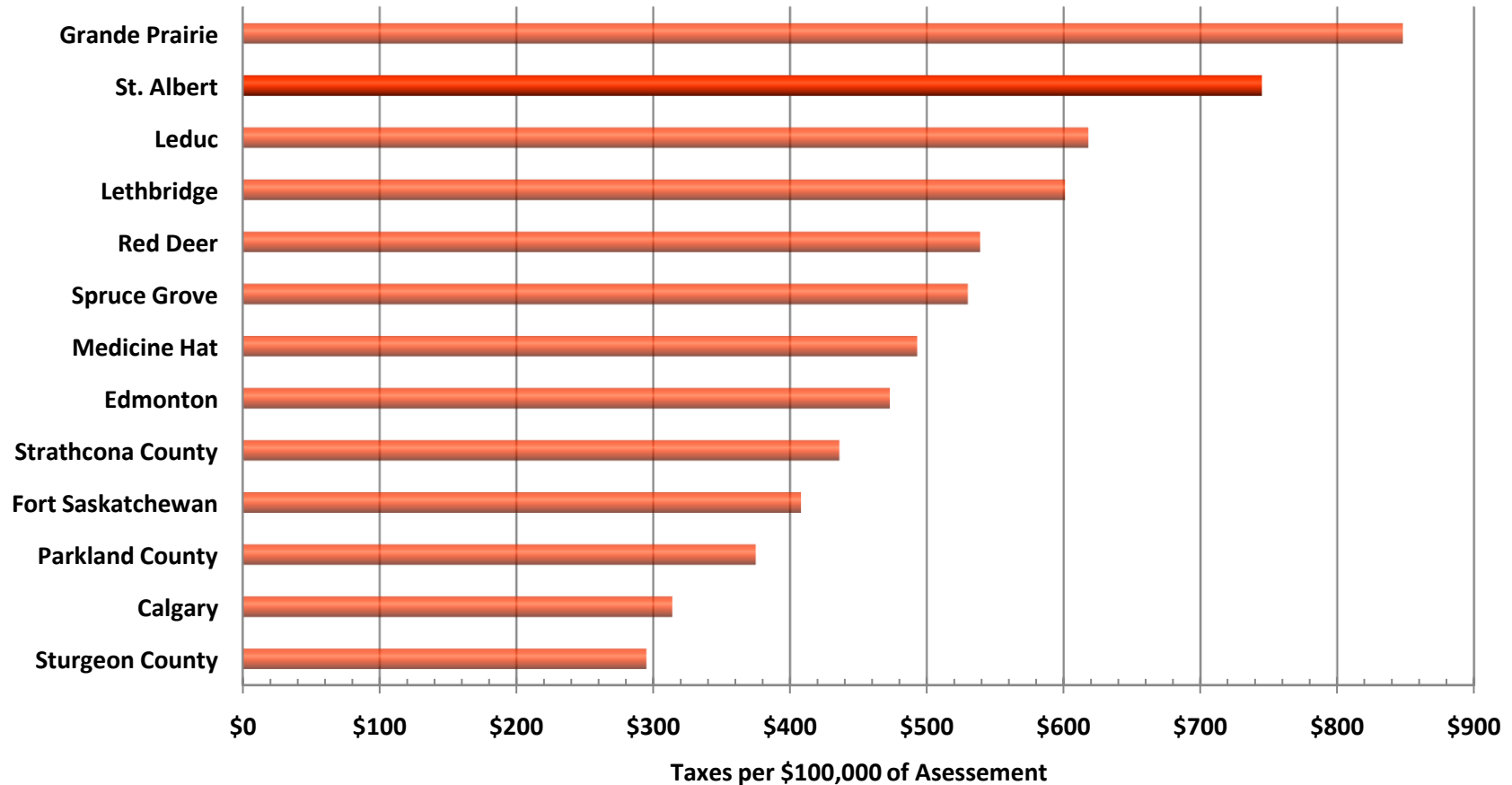


2010 Residential Property Taxes

Per \$100,000 of Assessed Value



The chart shows how residential property taxes collected by different municipalities throughout the Province vary for every \$100,000 of assessed value. Combined with the higher assessed values of residential properties in St. Albert, residents of St. Albert are paying the highest property taxes of the municipalities included in the survey.
